

POLICY ON CORPORATE INTERNSHIP ENROLMENT



Students may undertake a maximum of one full time semester (50%) in Corporate Internship Units.

The Corporate Internship Units available are:

- BAA 320 - 50%
- BAA 321 – 25%
- BAA 322- 12.5%

As no academic unit can be repeated and counted twice within any course, students can only undertake a 12.5% Internship (BAA 322) once. This is also the case for the 25% internship (BAA 321).

Therefore the following options are available to students enrolling in corporate internships:

- A once-only enrolment in any one of the corporate internship units.
- Either within one semester, or to spread internship studies over two semesters, a student could enrol in BAA 321 and BAA 322 (to provide a total of 37.5% in internship studies). This could enable them to undertake internship studies in more than one discipline area.

Many of the majors offered by the Faculty of Business include BAA 322 as a nominated elective. In these cases, a student may choose to undertake either BAA 320 or BAA321 in place of BAA 322, but to gain credit for the Major must complete the additional seven specified Major units. In this way, the balance of the internship in excess of 12.5% will count towards the course as elective/s, but will not be counted within the Major.
