

## 2009 Hoc Mai Student Bursary to Vietnam



The 2009 Hoc Mai Student Bursary is provided to enable up to two Year 4/5 medical students currently at the RCS to travel to Vietnam to undertake an elective during the summer break. The RCS is currently re-negotiating the elective program to include Hanoi and Da Nang.

This unique opportunity to gain first-hand experience of emergency medicine in a developing country is made possible through a collaboration between the University of Tasmania's Rural Clinical School and Hoc Mai, the Australian Vietnam Medical Foundation.

The \$5,000 Bursary will cover return airfares, accommodation and other expenses during the stay.

Applications are now open and must include:

- A completed application form (available at [www.rcs.utas.edu.au](http://www.rcs.utas.edu.au) under Scholarships)
- Two Letters of Reference, one from a clinical tutor at the RCS
- A proposal (1000 words) for a project to be undertaken as part of the elective.

A Selection Committee will also review applicants' clinical competence and academic record.

The successful student(s) will be required to submit a project report at the end of the elective period and make a Health Forum presentation in 2010.
