



My Degree Planner

- Consult the UTAS Course and Unit Handbook for the units of your degree – these are presented in Schedules.
- Use this planner to list the units you wish to study and to plan out your degree.
- Entry to the 63F Bachelor of Information Systems – Bachelor of Laws (BIS-LLB) combined degree can occur by direct entry, or after completion of the first year of the 73F Bachelor of Information Systems (BIS). Entry to the 63A Bachelor of Laws (LLB) degree is also possible after completion of the first year of the BIS. In all of these cases, the first eight introductory units must follow BIS rules.
- The introductory level units for your BIS major, minor and one of your degree electives are fixed and are shown here. You will need to select another introductory level degree elective from the three options shown.
- You must include LAW121 and LAW122 in your electives if you have gained direct entry to the BIS-LLB combined degree, or are seeking entry to the BIS-LLB or the Bachelor of Laws in 2011 (available on the Hobart campus only).

What are the requirements for my degree?

You need to complete 40 units over five years:

The BIS component consists of a major (8 units), a minor (4 units) and degree electives (4 units). LAW121 and LAW122 would normally be student electives under the BIS, however, here they are treated as BIS degree electives for the purposes of the BIS-LLB.

The Bachelor of Laws (LLB) component consists of two majors (16 units), an additional 8 units at the advanced level, plus a zero-weighted Mooting unit (not shown).

Overall, students complete 8 introductory level units, 12 intermediate level units, 20 advanced level units, plus the Mooting unit.

The BIS component consists of 16 units as follows: a **Major** (2 introductory, 2 intermediate & 4 advanced units), a **Minor** (2 introductory & 2 intermediate units) and **4 Degree Electives** (LAW121, LAW122 & 2 introductory units completed in first year).

Post BIS first year, the LLB component consists of 24 units as follows: **2 Majors** (4 intermediate & 4 advanced units per major), an additional **8 advanced level units** (of which one unit will be from Information Systems), plus a Mooting unit (not shown).
