63G Bachelor of Computing and Bachelor of Laws

Also: Introductory level units for
73D Bachelor of Computing (+ Intro to Law + Legal Systems),
for entry into 63G (or 63A) after first year

- Consult the UTAS Course and Unit Handbook for the units of your degree – these are presented in Schedules.
- Use this planner to list the units you wish to study and to plan out your degree.
- Entry to the 63G Bachelor of Computing – Bachelor of Laws (BComp-LLB) combined degree can occur by direct entry, or after completion of the first year of the 73D Bachelor of Computing (BComp). Entry to the 63A Bachelor of Laws (LLB) degree is also possible after completion of the first year of the BComp. In all of these cases, the first eight introductory units must follow BComp rules.
- For the BComp component of the combined degree, you can choose either a Computing Major (with choice of Minor) or a Games Technology Major (with Computing Minor). You also need to select two introductory level degree electives. See the BComp Schedule for your major, minor and degree elective options.
- You must include LAW121 and LAW122 in your electives if you have gained direct entry to the BComp-LLB combined degree, or are seeking entry to the BComp-LLB or the Bachelor of Laws in 2012 (available on the Hobart campus only).

What are the requirements for my degree?

You need to complete 40 units over five years:

The BComp component consists of a major (8 units), a minor (4 units) and degree electives (4 units). LAW121 and LAW122 would normally be student electives under the BComp, however, here they are treated as BComp degree electives for the purposes of the BComp-LLB.

The Bachelor of Laws (LLB) component consists of two majors (16 units), an additional 8 units at the advanced level, plus a zero-weighted Mooting unit (not shown).

Overall, students complete 8 introductory level units, 12 intermediate level units, 20 advanced level units, plus the Mooting unit.

The BComp component consists of 16 units as follows: a **Major** (2 introductory, 2 intermediate & 4 advanced units), a **Minor** (2 introductory & 2 intermediate units) and **4 Degree Electives** (LAW121, LAW122 & 2 introductory units completed in first year).

Post BComp first year, the LLB component consists of 24 units as follows: **2 Majors** (4 intermediate & 4 advanced units per major), an additional **8 advanced level units** (of which one unit will be from Computing), plus a Mooting unit (not shown).
