



## My Degree Planner

### 73C Bachelor of Computing - Bachelor of Economics

- Consult the UTAS Course and Unit Handbook for the units of your degree – these are presented in Schedules.
- Use this planner to help plan out your degree. Your introductory level units are fixed and are shown here. For the Computing component, you need to use the BComp Schedules to select 4 introductory computing units – 2 for a BComp Major and 2 for a BComp Minor (linked to the Major). For the Economics component, the introductory units shown count towards either an Economic Analysis or Economic Foundations Major, and an Economics Minor.

#### What are the requirements for my degree?

You need to complete 32 units, consisting of a major in each degree (16 units), a minor in each degree (8 units) and 4 degree electives in each degree (8 units). You need to ensure that the total number of units in the degree complies with the ranges below:

**Introductory level:** a minimum of 8 and a maximum of 12 units

**Intermediate level:** a minimum of 8 and a maximum of 16 units

**Advanced level:** a minimum of 8 and a maximum of 16 units

#### What are degree electives?

**Degree electives** are units chosen from the degree Schedules. For each component of this combined degree, you can select up to 2 degree electives at the introductory level. Your remaining degree electives must be intermediate / advanced level units.
